With this letter we are sharing information regarding the use of Google G Suite for Education in the Brocton Central School District and requesting parental permission for your PreK-8 student use of Google Apps.

The following services are available to each student and hosted by Google as part of Mt. Olivet Junior Academy's online presence in G Suite for Education

Docs -a word processing, spreadsheet, drawing, and presentation toolset that is very similar to Microsoft Office

Calendar - an individual calendar providing the ability to organize schedules, daily activities, and assignments

Mail - (for grades K-8) –an individual internal email account for school use managed, monitored, and filtered by Mt. Olivet SDA Junior Academy. Students will only have access to send/receive email to/from students, teachers within the school. Also, some individually approved educational sites, colleges, all MOJA teachers/staff members.

Drive – a place to store documents, pictures, and other data within Google's online storage. **YouTube**- a place to view, share and create online videos (Mt. Olivet SDA Junior Academy uses YouTube's Restricted Mode. Restricted Mode is an optional setting that has been available since 2010, and is used by a small subset of users, such as libraries, schools, and public institutions, who choose to have a more limited viewing experience on YouTube.) Classroom - Google Classroom is a free web service developed by Google for schools that aims to simplify creating, distributing, and grading assignments. The primary purpose of Google Classroom is to streamline the process of sharing files between teachers and students.

Using these tools, students collaboratively create, edit, and share files and websites for school related projects and communicate via email with other students and teachers. These services are entirely online and available 24/7 from any Internet-connected computer. Examples of student use include showcasing class projects, building an electronic portfolio of school learning experiences, and working in small groups on presentations to share with others Google G Suite for Education use in Mt. Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

FERPA protects the privacy of student education records and gives parents the rights to review student records. Under FERPA, schools may disclose directory information, but parents may request the school not disclose this information. Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA)

COPPA applies to commercial companies and limits their ability to collect personal information from children under 13. By default, advertising is turned off for Brocton Central School District's presence in Google Apps for Education. No personal student information is collected by Google for commercial purposes. This permission form allows the school to act as an agent for parents in the collection of information within the school context. The school's use of student information is solely for education purposes. Student information that is "collected" by Google is described as (projects, documents, email, files, username and password).
